Business as Usual while Bargaining Continues

Although the contract for Syracuse University is set to expire on June 30, there is *no change* in day-to-day operations at the University.

Employees can still use benefit time and will continue to be paid their normal rates. The negotiating committee confirmed the same: "We're still negotiating. Until we reach a resolution, even if the contract expires, it is business as usual. Nothing is changing until we have that final, signed agreement in hand."

The negotiating committee is continuing to work within the bargaining process and will be reconvening with management in July. The bargaining process will include issues such as subcontracting and retroactive raises; all of which continue to be negotiated.

Please be aware that nothing changes even as the contract expires. You still have benefit time and still will be paid as per the previous contract. If you have any questions about bargaining or your rights with and without a contract, please contact your steward.
