I hereby authorize SEIU 200United to file this payroll deduction form on my behalf with my employer to withhold (check one: [\$2] [\$3] [\$5]) per week, and forward that amount to SEIU COPE Fund.

I understand that I am not required to sign this form or make SEIU COPE contributions as a condition of my employment by my employer or membership in the Union; I may refuse to contribute without any reprisal. Only Union members and executive/administrative staff who are U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents are eligible to contribute to SEIU COPE; the amounts on this form are merely a suggestion, and I may contribute more or less by this or some other means without fear of favor or disadvantage from the Union or my employer. SEIU COPE uses the money it receives for political issues of public importance and contributing to and spending money in connection with federal, state, and local elections. Contributions to SEIU COPE are not deductible for federal income tax purposes. This authorization shall remain in effect until revoked in writing by me to the below address.
